Story

Sandscape is a silent theatrical piece that embraces the Beauty and Essence of Nature and evokes the visual, heart-rhythmic abilities that get you transfixed with the aid of Sand as its major tool. With the accompaniment of black plastic nylon, cups, umbrellas, and buckets. The piece immerses the audience into a world of playful experience. It is a relaxing and engaging piece of theatre that explores the texture, weight, and breath of sand on various materials.



Step 1

All characters enter the stage and introduce themselves to the audience.



Step 2

Characters move back, looking at the sand, touching it, and waving to the audience.



Step 3

A character approaches a bucket on stage, followed by others curious about its contents. Another character moves to a different bucket, with others following to investigate.

Step 4

Three characters move to separate buckets filled with sand, while another character plays with the sand on the main stage.



Step 6

They lay down to play with the sand, sinking their hands beneath and pulling it up.



Step 7

All pick up small quantities of sand, releasing it through their folded palms. Characters return to the stage, releasing the sand in unison.

Eventually, they each find one pebble. They get curious about what it is and then expresses joy of finding something strange and new.



Step 9

Characters use sieves to filter the sand playfully, as they try to catch the filtered sand.



Step 10

A character creates a path on the sand with a brush, with others passing through it, singing and dancing.



Step 11

Characters take shelter under an umbrella as it rains sand giving the illusion of rain drops.



Step 12

They pour water on their palms, and they continue to play.



Step 13

The characters invite children on stage to play with the sand, promoting inclusivity and joy.
